Bonus material in *Sonichu #0* includes various advertisements for imaginary *Sonichu* products, "classic" *Sonichu* comic strips drawn outside of the narrative of the main comic book, and the first "Sub-Episode".

Once you learn the methodology you'll dive into the hands-on work, choose-your-own-adventure style: knock out a room, or even a single drawer; style a bookshelf; donate a sweater. Shira teaches that the most important thing you can do is start, and that small victories, achieved one at a time, will snowball into massive transformation. Broken into small, bite-sized chunks, *Minimalista* makes it clear that if the process is fun and easy to follow, anyone can learn the principles of editing and organization.
