The Spirit That Haunts Apr 07 2021 Rituals are passed through generation to generation and when in my generation, in the lineage of the ancestral spirits demanded that our service was required, we were not spared, Mau Mau had to resurrect as Mungiki, a seed to fullfil Mugo wa Kiburu Prophecy and as actual players that planted seeds of discord that ignited tribal clashes in Kenya.
